- Access to this service through over 300 Mobil outlets across New Zealand
- Each time you purchase petrol at a Mobile pump, regardless of where in New Zealand 5 cents per litre purchased will come back to the Cancer Society. All money raised will help the Cancer Society continue its work in information, support, health promotion and cancer research

What are we asking you to do?

- Send your family members a FnF Mobil fuel card – it doesn't cost to apply and they don't have to live in Northland
